CHAPTER EXECUTIVE PANEL (ChEP)

RESPONSIBILITIES

Chapter Strategy and Alignment

Align chapter activities with GCA's and Committees' overarching objectives and ensure consistency with the association's values.

Leadership and Mentorship

Provide guidance, mentorship, and support to local chapter leaders (ChLs), helping them effectively manage chapter affairs and initiatives. Serve as role models by demonstrating leadership qualities and embodying GCA's commitment to excellence.

Engagement and Collaboration

Facilitate communication and collaboration between local chapter leaders, ensuring the exchange of best practices, ideas, and resources. Foster a sense of community among local chapters by organizing virtual meetings, workshops, and events.

Chapter Growth and Expansion

Identify opportunities for launching new chapters in underserved regions and assist in the setup and development of those chapters. Support existing chapters in their growth efforts by providing guidance on membership recruitment and engagement strategies.

Governance and Compliance
